Bibliographical notes



Specialists in the plant sciences frequently find it necessary to interrupt an investigation to learn the identity of an author of an erstwhile anonymous work, to determine the actual publication date of a title (or the dates of its parts, and their pagination, when issued serially), or to ascertain more details about the production or publication of a particular volume. Others may uncover similar data in the course of routine activity. Such information unfortunately, becomes buried too often in a monograph, or is set aside for future use and never made public.

This department of Huntia provides a publication medium for such findings. More important, it offers the scholar the opportunity to document the report with facsimiles of relevant titlepages, errata slips, prospecti, and other supporting evidence, thus providing the reader with both the data and the conclusions.
