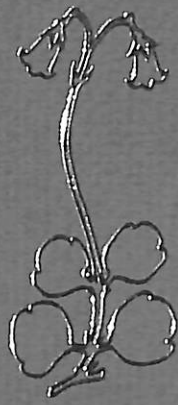

§ Prologue

The Linnaean Symposium celebrates the opening of the Strandell Room of the Hunt Botanical Library. This new room houses the Strandell Collection of Linnaeana, purchased by the library from Dr. Birger Strandell of Stockholm in 1968. The collection is second in the world only to the University of Uppsala for the works of Carl Linnaeus and all of his students. For secondary works about these men, the Strandell Collection is without peer.

The Hunt Botanical Library is proud to include this outstanding assemblage of printed material—so significant to the history and development of botany, zoology, and medicine—in its collection, and to recognize that event by organizing a Linnaean Symposium which brings together an outstanding group of scholars concerned with Linnaeus and his students, and the impact of their work on modern science.
